The training has a hybrid character: an online workshop with input lectures and Q&As is combined with an intensive on-site training course. High-ranking professional trainers and speakers will conduct the online workshop and the on-site training courses. Workshop and training are open for STEM graduates from Egypt, Palestine and other neighboring Arab countries.

The online workshop will include but not be limited to the following topics:

- Enhancement of the marketability skills.
- Scholarship application strategies and research skills.
- The concept of interdisciplinarity.
- Innovation and transfer activities: recommendations for startups.
- Leadership and entrepreneurial skills.

Besides the online workshop, there will be an intensive training course for selected participants at the premises of the Academy for Scientific Research and Technology (ASRT) in Cairo, Egypt. At the same time, two training courses will take place in Palestine at the Islamic University of Gaza (IUG) and at the Palestine Polytechnic University (PPU) in Hebron. Travel and accommodation costs can be covered for participants with long travel distances.

The on-site training course will include but not be limited to the following topics/agenda points:

- Interview training
- Emotional intelligence
- Entrepreneurship skills
