We kindly invite you to apply for a two day AGYA Screenprint Workshop with Katharina Marszewski (Visual Artist, Berlin, www.kmworks.de) hosted at the Goethe-Institut in Cairo. The workshop will be organized in the framework of the book presentation of the AGYA publication 'Brigitte Schiffer: Letters from Cairo, 1935–1963'.

Aim of the AGYA Screenprint Workshop is to bring closer the specific use of silkscreen as it was partly used to enroll possibilities of creating the book publication as well as sharing methods of de- & re-constructing given historical images.

Everyone who is interested in experimenting with this technique is invited to hand in their application. No previous experience in screenprinting is necessary. All material will be provided. The workshop is open up to six participants and will be held in English. Selected printed matter will be exhibited at the Goethe-Institut Kairo in Dokki, Cairo, at the evening event of the book presentation on 23 November 2022.
